

Everyone will get to participate in Front Row Duty. Front row duties include the following:

- being on time for class,
- talking to at least 2 of the following types of people for a minute or two at the start of class (a neighbor on Front Row Duty, a Discussion Section Instructor, Professor Brady),
- being prepared to answer questions addressed to the class.

Remember that participation in Front Row Duty will be monitored, and will count for 2% of your overall grade in the course.
