We offer the MS, MA and PhD degrees. The PhD degree is available in a broad range of areas of pure and applied mathematics, and in research in undergraduate mathematics education.

Most students are employed as Graduate Teaching Assistants (GTAs) while earning their degrees. As a new GTA, your transition into the role of educator will be facilitated by a lighter load in your first year, and by your participation in our graduate teaching seminar.

The OU Math graduate program is comprised of around 70 graduate students, of whom over 40% are women. Our current graduate students represent over a dozen different countries around the globe.
- **You will experience a strong graduate student seminar culture.**  
Currently our graduate students run six seminar series, and are responsible for approximately one half of talks given in our department. These seminars are excellent venues for peer mentoring and for discussing topics of key interest to our students.
- **You get to interact with a diverse group of faculty.**  
You will join a community of 34 permanent faculty and 8 to 10 post-doctoral associates. Our faculty maintain a vibrant and collegial research atmosphere, and also serve as sources of inspiration, as mentors and advisors. Our strong sense of community is enhanced by the fact that faculty, post-doctoral and student offices, common room, research library, and instructional classrooms are all housed in the same building.
